



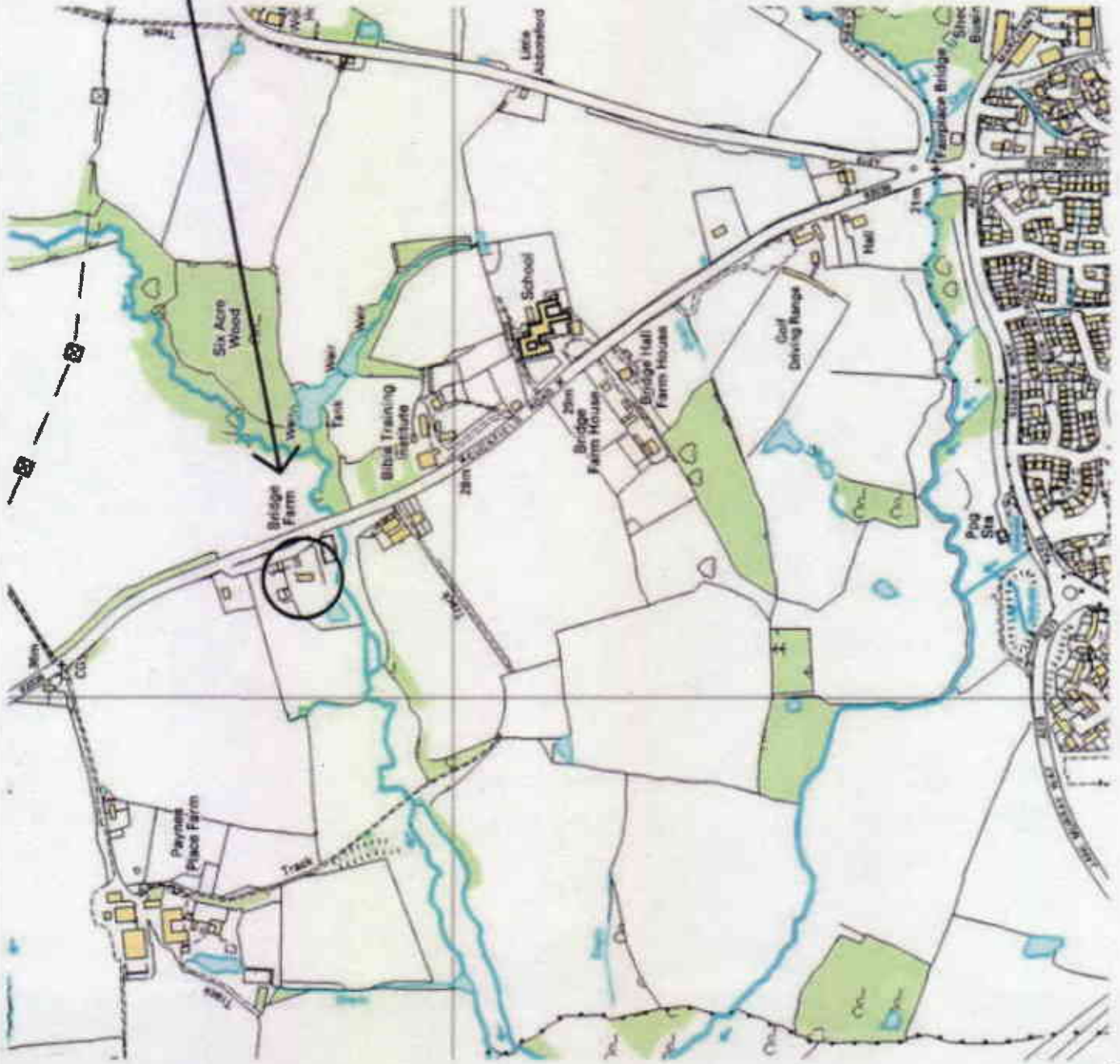
600kg Ammonium Nitrate Fertiliser

Defence admits that Anthony Garcia purchased 600kg of ammonium nitrate-based fertilizer on November 6, 2003 at Bodle Bros. Ltd., Southdown Store, Burgess Hill, West Sussex at a cost of 90 pounds and VAT.

Defence admits that 600kg of ammonium nitrate-based fertiliser was stored at Access Self Storage at 145-147 Boston Road, Hanwell, London under the care and control of Omar Khyam and Nabeel Hussain from November 11, 2003 up until their arrest on March 30, 2004 and that storage costs were £207.45 (including VAT) per month.

Defence admits the evidence of Stephen Moore, Senior Forensic Practitioner, London Metropolitan Police, who would testify that analysis of the 600 kilograms of fertilizer seized indicates 77% ammonium nitrate content.

Defence admits the installation and functioning of the British Security Service (BSS) audio probes in Omar Khyam's Suzuki Vitara vehicle (licence plate GV53 WHA) and at 56 Hencroft Street South, Slough, and admits the audio probes (subject to legal arguments regarding their admissibility considering the rule against hearsay and available exceptions) and the accuracy of the transcripts.

Defence admits the identity of speakers as indicated in the transcripts of the BSS audio probes.

Defence admits that Momin Khawaja participated in conversations in the United Kingdom that were recorded by audio probes in the Suzuki Vitara (license plate GV53 WHA – Hobbit) operated by Omar Khyam and at 56 Hencroft Street South, during the period February 20, 2004 through February 22, 2004.

Defence admits the movements, locations, times and identities of individuals identified by BSS physical surveillance. In particular, Defence admits that Momin Khawaja is the individual identified as "Undue Haste".

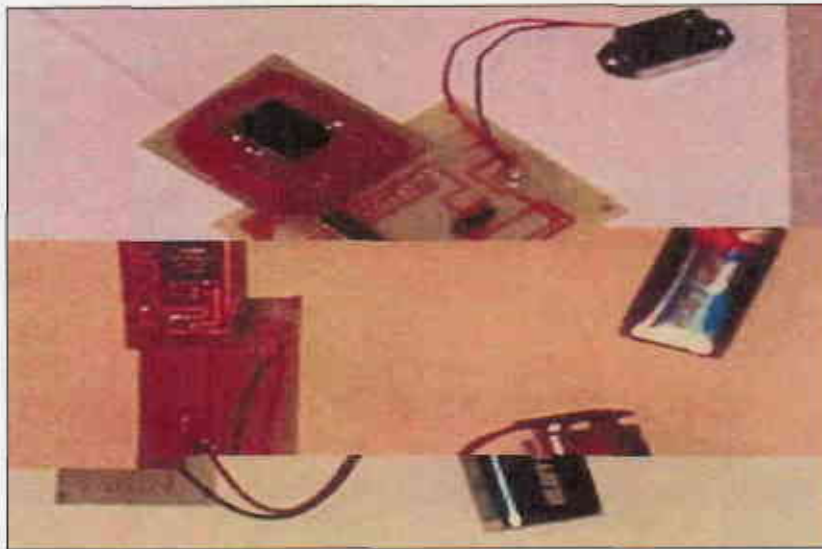


Image of Hifidigimonster from Universal Video Hard Drive

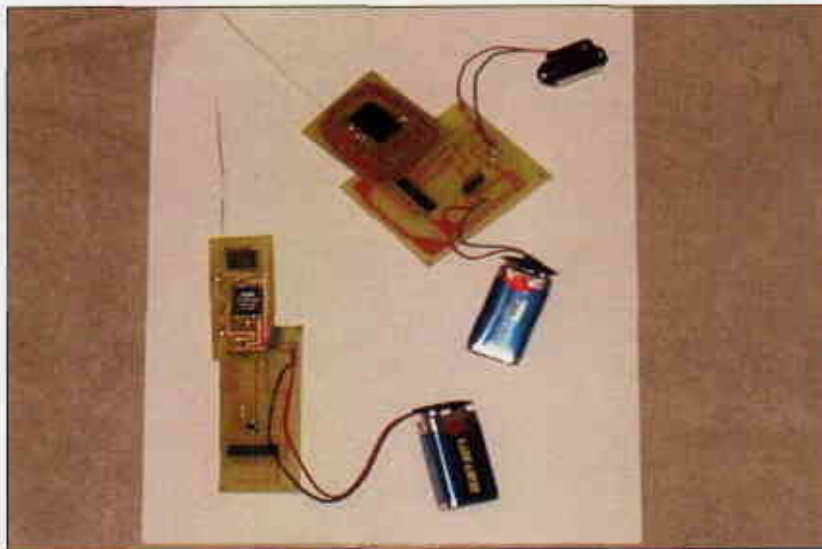


Image of Hifidigimonster from digital photograph
