## Introduction and Methodology

- ◆ *The Strategic Counsel* is pleased to present findings of a national telephone omnibus survey of 1,000 Canadians.
- ◆ Results are based on a proportionate national sample of Canadians 18 years of age or older.
- ◆ Interviews were conducted between February 5<sup>th</sup> and February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
- ◆ The following table outlines the sample distribution and associated margin of error.
- ◆ Note: Proportions may not sum to 100% due to rounding.

## Sample Distribution and Margin of Error

National Sample Regions	Sample Size	Margin of Error ( ± )
Canada	1000	3.1%
Quebec	244	6.3%
Rest of Canada	758	3.6%
Ontario	384	5.0%
West	300	5.7%

**Note:** Because of the smaller sample size, the margin of error for demographic breakdowns and other subsamples is significantly larger than for the overall percentages.
